I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Templeton called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

II. ROLL CALL

III. COMMITTEE BUSINESS

A. Public Safety: Rights of Individual vs. Well Being of the Community

The Committee received and discussed presentations from Mark Odom, Orange County Health Care Agency Older Adult Services, and Andrea Portenier, Orange County Health Care Agency Tobacco Use Prevention Program. Mr. Odom discussed the Older Adult Services response to mental and behavioral health issues related to hoarding, as well as the Orange County Task Force on Hoarding. Ms. Portenier provided the Committee with information on the public health effects of secondhand smoke, as well as what other municipalities are doing to protect public health and safety. She noted that Laguna Woods has some of the most aggressive anti-smoking regulations in the county.

The Committee unanimously voted to consider an ordinance that would ban smoking on patios and balconies. Staff will draft an ordinance and bring it to the Committee for further discussion at a later date.

City Manager Keane explained that contrary to the public comment at the March 2010 meeting, the Sheriff's Department has no record of responding to crimes at A Place for Paws/Ridge Route Linear Park.
